Non-Accessible Content

The content listed below is non-accessible for the following reasons. Non-compliance with the WCAG 2.1 accessibility regulations, with the relevant success criterion listed in italics:

- Certain website processes are timed and not *Timing Adjustable*, for security reasons.
- A mechanism is not available to *Bypass Blocks* of content that are repeated on multiple pages.
- Not all text and images can be resized to 200%. A bespoke *Resize Text* view is under consideration.
- Some content or functionality may be lost when the user adapts the text line height / spacing or font size or content is presented at a width of 320 pixels / 400% zoom. A bespoke *Text Spacing* / Reflow view is under consideration.
